**THE LAND**

Spend two nights at the Waikiki Beach Marriott Resort and Spa, complete with swimming pools, shops, restaurants, lounges, Waikiki Beach, and much more. The hotel is a short walk to other attractions such as the International Market Place, Waikiki Aquarium, and the Honolulu Zoo. You’ll have time to explore Pearl Harbor, the USS Arizona Memorial-Museum and see Mighty Mo, the movie. We’ll make our way to the Dole Plantation, where we’ll experience two miles of pineapple fun on the Pineapple Express train. This fully narrated tour will tell you the story of the pineapple in Hawaii, how James Drummond Dole founded his world-famous agricultural empire, and you’ll travel through the stunning scenery of the island’s famous North Shore. Take the Plantation Garden tour and wander through any of the different gardens where you’ll get an up-close view of the plants that are the source of tropical delights from coffee to exotic fruit to colorful cacao pods. You’ll learn which plants were sacred, how plants were cooked and how native Hawaiians used these plants for everything they needed. You’ll also enjoy a demonstration on how to cut a pineapple.

**THE PORTS**

**Honolulu**

The big, blue Pacific and stunning Koolau mountains serve as a dramatic setting for Hawaii’s largest city. Climb to the top of Diamond Head, or take a romantic stroll on Waikiki Beach.

**Maui (Kahului)**

A surplus of natural splendor and the genuine hospitality of its people have helped to make Maui Hawaii’s second most popular island. Explore the fascinating history of the town of Lahaina, picnic at a nearby plantation, sun yourself on a pristine beach or play one of the world’s most beautiful golf courses.

**Hilo**

The entire city of Hilo is like one giant greenhouse with spectacular tropical flowers at every turn. Visit the town’s well-preserved historic buildings, which showcase Hawaii’s unique architecture, or visit the Hawaii Volcanoes National Park, just 30 miles away.

**Kona**

Kona offers the quintessential Hawaii experience. Sunny, warm weather and crystal blue waters entice visitors to partake in a variety of surfside fun including snorkeling, surfing lessons, kayaking, or deep-sea fishing.

**Kauai**
