



Healthy Winter Recipes

Baked Squash Gratin

Makes 6 servings

INGREDIENTS

1 (3-pound) butternut squash, peeled, seeded and cut into 1-inch cubes
Salt and freshly ground black pepper, to taste
1/2 cup freshly grated Parmesan
1/4 cup purchased basil pesto
2 TB unsalted butter, cut into 1/2-inch pieces, plus more for greasing

DIRECTIONS

1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F.
2. Lightly butter an 8-inch baking dish and set aside. Fill a large pot with enough water to come 2 inches up the sides of the pot. Set a steamer rack in the pot, cover, and bring the water to a boil. Add squash and steam over medium heat until squash is very tender, about 20 minutes. Transfer squash to a food processor and blend until smooth and creamy. Season to taste with salt and pepper.
3. Spoon 1/2 of the squash evenly over the prepared baking dish. Dollop half of the pesto all over the squash in the dish. Sprinkle half the cheese over the squash. Repeat layering with the remaining squash, pesto, and cheese. Dot the top with butter and bake until the gratin is heated through, about 40 minutes.

Healthy Makeover Eggnog

Makes 6-1/2 cups

INGREDIENTS

3 large eggs
5 1/2 cups low-fat milk
2 TB cornstarch
1/2 TSP (plus additional for sprinkling) ground nutmeg
1/3 cup dark Jamaican rum (optional)
Salt

DIRECTIONS

1. In bowl, with whisk, beat eggs and egg whites until blended; set aside. In heavy 4-quart saucepan, with heat-safe spatula, mix 4 cups milk with sugar, cornstarch, and 1/4 teaspoon salt. Cook on medium-high until mixture boils and thickens slightly, stirring constantly. Boil 1 minute. Remove saucepan from heat.
2. Gradually whisk 1/2 cup simmering milk mixture into eggs; pour egg mixture back into milk in saucepan, whisking constantly, to make custard.
3. Pour custard into large bowl; stir in vanilla, nutmeg, rum, if using, and remaining 1 1/2 cups milk. Cover and refrigerate until well chilled, at least 6 hours or up to 2 days. Sprinkle eggnog with nutmeg to serve.
